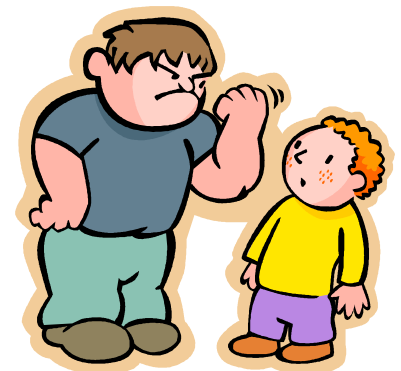

► What is Bullying?

Bullying can be when someone does all or some of these things to you:

- Hitting, punching or pulling hair
- Name calling using any kind of names that you do not like
- Using bad words
- Stealing from you
- Kicking
- Spitting
- Scaring you through texts or social networking (cyber bullying)

Bullying happens when someone is horrible to you a lot and you feel like it happens all the time. It can make you feel scared or sad.

If something happens once, that may not be bullying but you should still tell someone.

What can you do?

You must tell someone if you or someone you know is being bullied.

Who can you tell?

You can tell any adult you feel comfortable talking to.
