Dear Parents, Guardians and friends of St. Joseph's,

We are delighted to welcome you all back to our new school year. Thank you to all the parents for assisting in the early morning routines, this has ensured a very smooth start to the morning lessons and the school term. Parents are reminded that children line up in the playground and teachers collect children from the playground and take them to class.



Children are making great efforts to get into school on time- well done everyone!

This is essential so that children do not miss any of the learning that starts as soon as we get into the classroom. Remember, late children need to go in through the office as all of the other doors will be closed as soon as the lines are brought in at 8.55am.

All parents are asked to ensure all uniform items are labelled including the black plimsolls for indoor wear and P.E. It is important that all children have indoor shoes. It is expected that all children have a full school P.E. uniform — white polo shirt and navy P.E. shorts. Please remember to label all parts of your children's uniforms as changing for P.E. can cause a few mix-ups! Please remember that children should wear black school shoes to school at all times!

School dinners are £2.60 for any children wishing to have a hot dinner. If you feel you may be entitled to free school meals we would advise you to collect a form from the office and apply as soon as possible as you will not be able to avail of this service until the application has been processed by the Board. Dinner menus can be found on the school website. Please remember that break time snacks must be healthy!

We ask that all parents drive with care in the car parks and use the parking spaces provided. This is essential for the safety of all children and we have been receiving reports that speeding and unsafe parking are placing children in danger.

We will be facilitating the Public Health Agency in the administration of the flu vaccine for all children P1-P7. This will happen on Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> November. Please speak to your child's teacher if there is a reason why your child should not be vaccinated.

Consent forms should be returned to school as the nursing service are clear that any child who does not have a signed consent form **WILL NOT** receive the vaccine at school.

#### **SHARED EDUCATION**

Well done to P.6 who have started working on a shared programme on their topic Titanic with the P.6 class from Greystone Primary School. They have enjoyed their joint sessions so far and showing off their learning with each other. All classes this year will have an opportunity to work with pupils from Greystone in the Shared Education Programme. Teachers will inform you of the arrangements.
